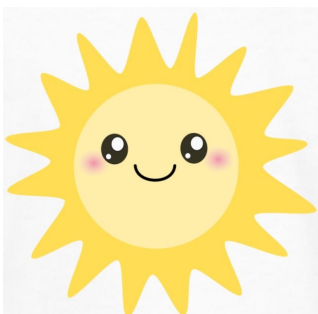
Joke of the week:
