Updates on Learning at Seagrave

We are excited to announce the implementation of a new sequential, knowledge-rich curriculum called STRIDE, designed specifically for our amazing Seagrave pupils. Additionally, we have introduced new values to our school named the **Seagrave Steps**. Each value is represented by an animal, embodying qualities that we believe will help every pupil achieve excellence in their learning journey. We have been exploring these values during our weekly story assemblies, and I am delighted to see how much the children have embraced them. To reinforce these values, we have a class set of teddies representing each Step, which are awarded throughout lesson to pupils who exemplify these qualities.



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We have transformed our reading approach at Seagrave. In EYFS and KS1, we will continue with the Read Write Inc. phonics scheme, we have invested in training and more phonics reading books - these will start to come home in the New year. For Year 2 and above, we are excited to launch our Reading Ninja approach, featuring three weekly whole-class reading sessions focused on different strategies. Student feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. Additionally, we are working on fundraising to update our library space.

A quick update about homework. Starting now, homework will focus solely on spellings, reading, and maths facts (times tables and number bonds). Research shows that parental support in these areas significantly improves student outcomes! In class, we have 'Strive for 5' reading jars. Students who read five times a week earn a raffle ticket for a chance to pick a new book. KS2 pupils can access Times Table

Rock Stars at home, and teachers will share weekly spellings. We hope this new approach is supportive and manageable for your family.
